



Banta Elementary School District LCAP Meeting

Dear Parents:

California's 2013-2014 Budget Act included legislation to simplify the state's school finance system. The change introduced the new Local Control Funding Formula, or LCFF. LCFF funds districts differently than in the past by creating a base funded on a per pupil basis that is the same across the state. In addition, LCFF creates supplemental funding that is designated to target students in need of extra support.

We need your help. To assist districts with figuring out how to use LCFF funds to best serve students, and to make sure the students get the support they need, districts must create a Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). In this plan, we must address 8 target areas clustered in 3 groups: Conditions of Learning, Pupil Outcomes, and Engagement. We need input from parents, community members, staff, and students.

2018-2019 is year five for the district's LCAP plan. In an effort to gather feedback Banta Elementary School District has planned outreach meetings for parents and community members. Our first meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 26, 2018.

Your involvement is extremely valuable to us, so please be sure to attend an LCAP meeting.
